DAY ONE: Thursday, July 17

Highlights:

- Depart SeaTac @ 2:10am
- Fly all night

Scripture: Psalm 139: 9-10

If I could fly on the wings of dawn, stopping to rest only on the far side of the ocean – even there your hand would guide me; even there your strong hand would hold me tight!

Prayers:

- Protection and safety during the trip
- Trust God's presence
- Pray for rest on the plane
- Pray for the team's spiritual preparation and dependence on the Holy Spirit

DAY TWO: Friday, July 18

Highlights:

- Arrive in Taiwan @ 5:10am (4 hour layover)
- Arrive in Da Nang @ 11:35am
(14 hours ahead of PST)
- Meet FM Superintendent Hien

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 16:13-14

¹³Stay awake, stand firm in your faith, be brave, be strong. ¹⁴Everything should be done in love.

Prayers:

- For smooth transitions and no complications
- All the luggage and supplies arrive with the team
- Pray for the team's physical health, safety, and energy in the heat and long travel days
- Pray for unity among the team members and with their Vietnamese hosts.
- Pray for humility and a learning spirit in all team interactions

Your Thoughts:

DAY THREE: Saturday, July 19

Highlights:

- Morning – All Asia Prayer Time
- Afternoon – Travel to Hue City

Scripture: Ephesians 1:17-18

I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, will give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation that makes God known to you. I pray that the eyes of your heart will have enough light to see what is the hope of God's call, what is the richness of God's glorious inheritance among believers.

Prayers:

- Pray for the team's understanding of culture in Vietnam. Pray for spiritual insight, for a bond of love and compassion
- Pray for moments of quiet reflection for the team to hear God's voice clearly each day.

Your Thoughts:

DAY FOUR: Sunday, July 20

Highlights:

- Worship at Pastor Hien's FM Church – Pastor Camille preaching & team testimonies
- Evening – Boat on Perfume River

Scripture: Ephesians 2:19-22

So now you are no longer strangers and aliens. Rather, you are fellow citizens with God's people, and you belong to God's household. 20 As God's household, you are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. 21 The whole building is joined together in him, and it grows up into a temple that is dedicated to the Lord. 22 Christ is building you into a place where God lives through the Spirit.

Prayers:

- Pray for protection over the house churches and gathering that may draw government attention
- Pray for the translation and communication of the gospel to be clear, relevant, and Spirit-empowered
- Pray for deep and lasting relationships to be formed between the team and local believers

Your Thoughts:

DAY FIVE: Monday, July 21

Highlights:

- Travel to Da Nang – Hoi An for the Young Leaders' Conference

Scripture:

- Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
- Isaiah 50:4 The LORD God gave me an educated tongue to know how to respond to the weary with a word that will awaken them in the morning. God awakens my ear in the morning to listen, as educated people do.

Prayers:

- Pray for the Vietnamese pastors and leaders who will host and teach alongside the team
- Pray for people to come to faith in Jesus through one-on-one conversations and testimony sharing
- Pray for spiritual breakthrough in areas of fear, shame, and ancestral worship

Your Thoughts:

DAY SIX: Tuesday, July 22

Highlights:

- Meet & Greet 50+ FM youth at Conference (DAY ONE)
- Ministry and Testimony sharing

Scripture:

- 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always. Pray continually. Give thanks in every situation because this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
- Joshua 1:9 I've commanded you to be brave and strong, haven't I? Don't be alarmed or terrified because the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

Prayers:

- For opportunities to rejoice and give thanks for what God has done
- Pray for the participants traveling from all over Vietnam
- Pray for full funding of the event: program, lodging, travel, food, care – more than \$7,500
- Grace as we meet new people

Your Thoughts:

DAY SEVEN: Wednesday, July 23

Highlights:

- Young Leaders' Conference (DAY TWO)
- Training and Testimony sharing
- Games & Group activities

Scripture:

- Matthew 6:33 Instead, desire first and foremost God's kingdom and God's righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
- Philippians 2:1-2 Therefore, if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort in love, any sharing in the Spirit, any sympathy, 2 complete my joy by thinking the same way, having the same love, being united, and agreeing with each other.

Prayers:

- Give us eyes to see and ears to hear those who need special encouragement in their journey with Jesus
- Pray specifically for the training sessions for the young leaders, that they will help them go deep in their own faith and learn how to reach out with the gospel in their own villages

DAY EIGHT: Thursday, July 24

Highlights:

- Young Leaders' Conference (DAY THREE)
- Sharing & Reflection
- Commissioning & Prayer

Scripture: Romans 12: 1-2

So, brothers and sisters, because of God's mercies, I encourage you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice that is holy and pleasing to God. This is your appropriate priestly service. Don't be conformed to the patterns of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds so that you can figure out what God's will is—what is good and pleasing and mature.

Prayers:

- For restoration and great communication
- Pray for open hearts among young people at the leadership event – that seeds planted will grow into gospel movements
- Pray for long-term fruit – for lives to be changed, leaders to be equipped, and the church to grow in strength and unity.

DAY NINE: Friday, July 25

Highlights:

- Travel to Quan Ngai
- Meet FM Pastor Tang
- Prepare supplies and activities for Children's VBS

Scripture: Psalm 32:7-8

You are my secret hideout! You protect me from trouble.
You surround me with songs of rescue! 8 I will instruct
you and teach you about the direction you should go. I'll
advise you and keep my eye on you.

Prayers:

- Pray for the good news about Jesus and love of the Father to be shared with the children through games, ESL, and other interactions
- Pray for God's Word to take root in the hearts of those who hear it

Your Thoughts:

DAY TEN: Saturday, July 26

Highlights:

- Morning – Children’s VBS at Pastor Tang’s Church
- Afternoon – Fellowship & Prayer with FM Leaders
- Travel to Da Nang

Scripture: Matthew 19:14

“Allow the children to come to me,” Jesus said. “Don’t forbid them, because the kingdom of heaven belongs to people like these children.”

Prayers:

- Pray for the children in Quang Ngai to experience joy, safety, and the love of Jesus through the outreach
- For the kids to know that Jesus sees them and takes joy in their faith
- Energize the team for this long day; give us patience and discernment in our interactions
- Pray for God to raise up new leaders in Vietnam who are bold, faithful, and full of grace

Your Thoughts:

DAY ELEVEN: Sunday, July 27

Highlights:

- Sunday worship with FM House Church in Da Nang
- Team Members share Testimonies
- Afternoon – sightseeing & packing

Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10-11

"God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another. "Do you have the gift of speaking? Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. Then everything you do will bring glory to God through Jesus Christ. All glory and power to him forever and ever! Amen.

Prayers:

- Praise God for another opportunity to worship together with our Sisters and Brothers in Christ
- Pray for unity and the gifts of the Holy Spirit to be poured out as we authentically share
- Wisdom to wrap up our time well
- Pray for this small house church plant that this will be the start of significant ministry progress with a new model of outreach

- Pray for miraculous encounters with God that confirm His power and presence
